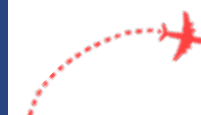
 Breakfast - Dinner

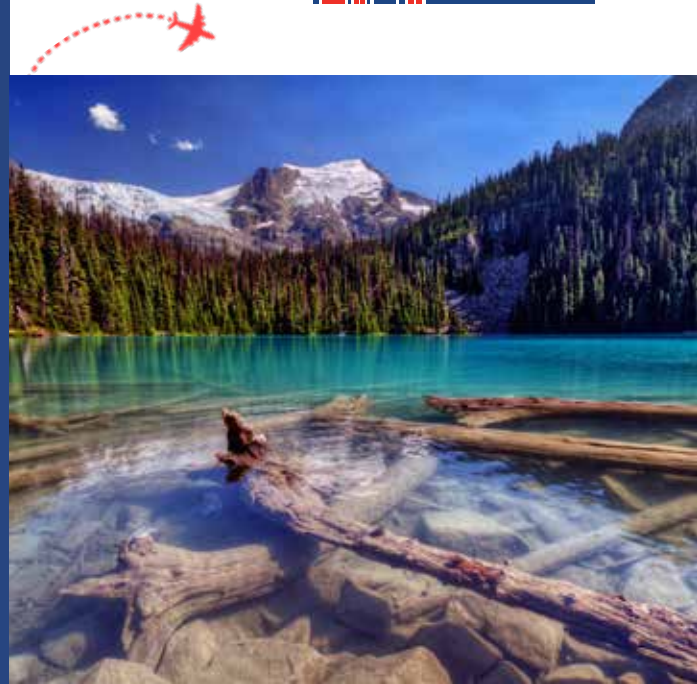
### JASPER. EXCURSION TO MALIGNE LAKE

Feel the force of nature's strength on an ancient glacier that still carves the face of the Rocky Mountains today.
